William H. Johnson painted his *Fighters for Freedom* series in the mid-1940s as a tribute to African American activists, scientists, teachers, and performers as well as international heads of state working to bring peace to the world. He celebrated their accomplishments even as he acknowledged the realities of racism, violence, and oppression they faced and overcame. Some of his Fighters — Harriet Tubman, George Washington Carver, Marian Anderson, and Mohandas Gandhi — are familiar historical figures; others are less well-known individuals whose determination and sacrifice have been eclipsed over time. Johnson elevates their lives visually, offering historical insights and fresh perspectives. Through their stories he suggests that the pursuit of freedom is an ongoing, interconnected struggle, with moments of both triumph and tragedy, and he invites us to reflect on our own struggles for justice today. In *Fighters for Freedom* Johnson reminds us that individual achievement and commitment to social justice are at the heart of the American story.

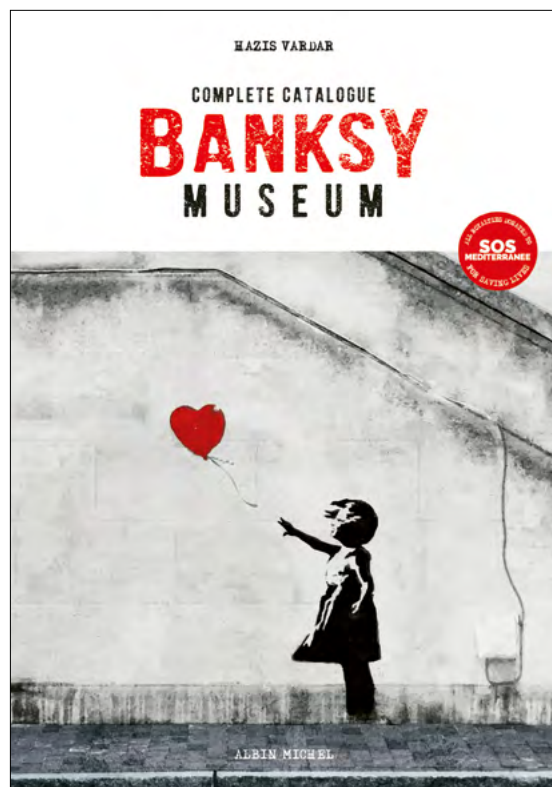

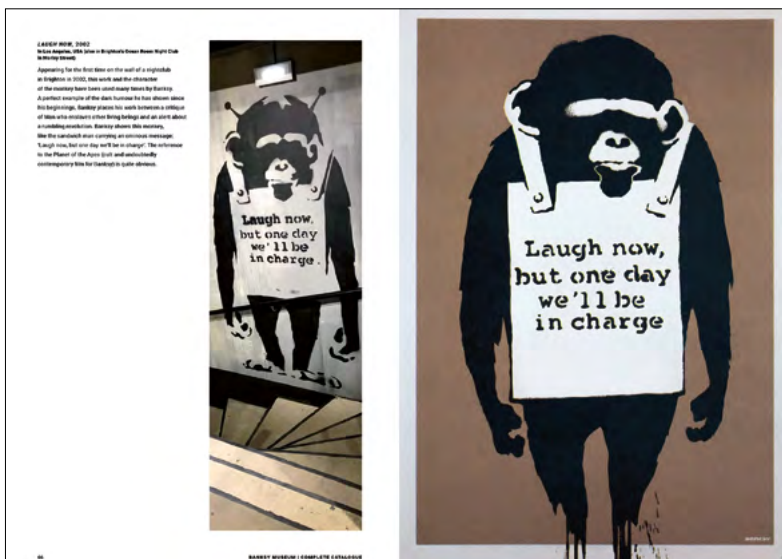

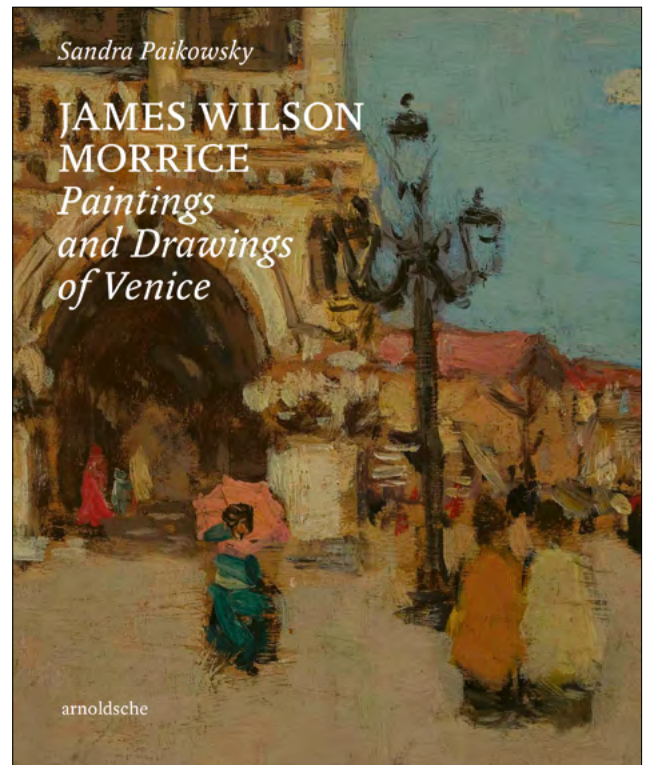

Living in Paris for most of his life, Morrice (1865–1924) was the first Canadian painter to make regular trips to Venice from the mid-1890s to about 1908. This book situates Morrice within the history of Venice and Venetian art in the late 19th and early 20th centuries by looking carefully at his more than 100 modernist paintings and numerous drawings of "La Serenissima." During his lifetime, Morrice's Venetian pictures appeared in art exhibitions in Paris, London and other European countries, as well as in Montreal and the United States. Constantly cited in exhibition reviews, Morrice was praised for his modernity, and his Venice works have ensured his fame and importance for years to come.

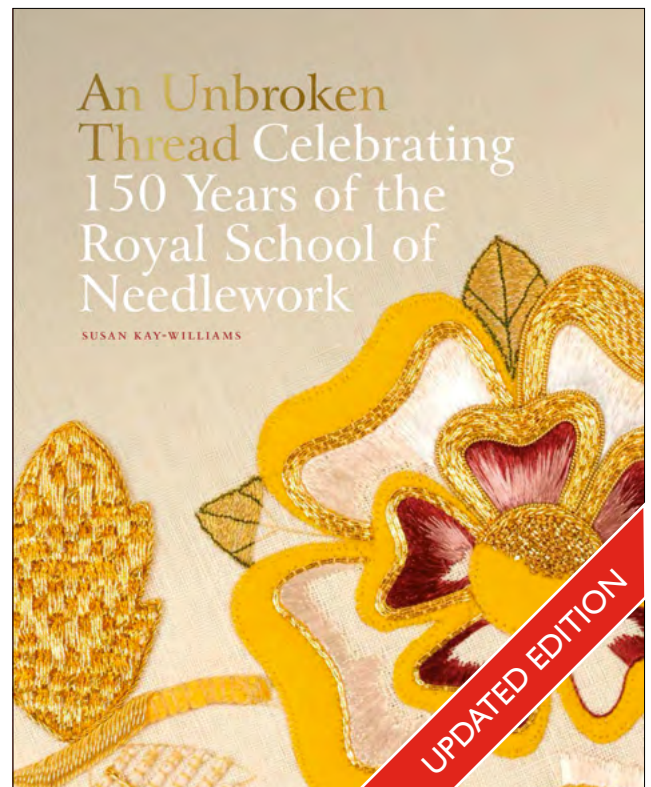


An Unbroken Thread Celebrating 150 Years of the Royal School of Needlework - updated edition

Many initiatives to support women were begun in the late 1800s, but the Royal School of Needlework (RSN) is one of the few that remain. This initiative was born from the desire of three women – Princess Helena, Lady Victoria Welby and Lady Marian Alford – to popularize the lost art of ornamental needlework and place it on a par with other decorative arts, such as painting and sculpture. Their other, yet no less important goal was to provide employment for women compelled to earn their own livelihood.

An Unbroken Thread tells the story from the RSN's founding in 1872 to the current day. It highlights key people, royal and other special commissions, the changing fortunes of the school as fashions changed and the approach to teaching hand embroidery, as well as bringing attention to the role and position of the RSN historically and today.

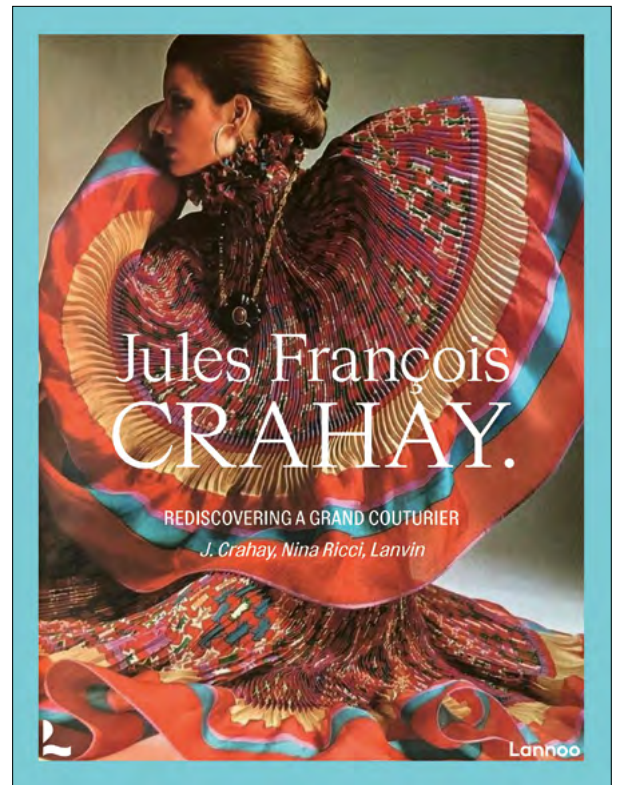


Jules François Crahay Rediscovering a Grand Couturier

The Royal Doulton Pottery, which bordered the Thames close to Lambeth Bridge, was one of the great industrial enterprises of Victorian England. It did not finally close its doors until 1956. Its offices, created in a style of architecture that we would now describe as High Victorian Gothic, still survive at the river's end of Black Prince Road.

This is an astonishingly ornate building, and a major piece of public art into the bargain. It is also one that shows off on the outside what is being manufactured indoors, on the factory's floors. The window ledges seem to push outwards at an exaggerated angle in order to allow us to see samples of the range of styles of decorative embellishment that the factory could offer any potential customer. Samples of wonderful individual tiles are embedded into the walls - it is a little like looking into a kaleidoscope. Best of all is to position yourself at the main entrance, exactly where Lambeth High Street meets Black Prince Road, and look up.

Every inch of the building has been attended to - the sides of the windows are decorated with ceramic sheaves of gleaming corn. Gargoyles project from close to the roof. You will see a lovely scene above the old main entrance, a ceramic panel - it is a little like a biblical scene carved into the pediment above the principal doorway of a church - which shows Mr Doulton crafting and examining one of his own urns in a crowded work room. He is surrounded by dutiful overseers and some workers. To his left a young woman is seated on a stool, hand-decorating an urn. He himself is standing beside her, with others looking on. Other Doultonware is ranged along a shelf at his back. Above this pediment the architecture takes flight once again - into lovely semi-circular offices that project over the street. Mr Doulton used to watch his barges leaving from one of these upper windows.

Where the navy's needs were served

Somerset House, one of London's finest neo-classical buildings, sits high on the north bank of the Thames, just a little to the east of London Bridge. The Thames is a swift-moving, mood-changing, tidal river, and there is much that links Sir William Chambers' ingenious and ostentatious building to seafaring and the sea.

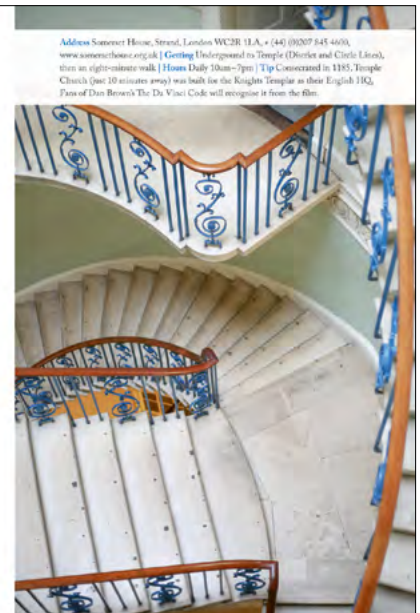
Walk through the great inner courtyard where ice skaters do their daring leaps and turns in the winter months, and you will see what I mean.

It was in the wing that overlooks the Thames that the Navy Board was once headquartered, and it is here that you will find a staircase that deserves to be re-categorised as a well-hidden, magnificent work of art in its own right. It is called the Nelson Stair. To find it, turn right off the Seaman's Waiting Hall, and just keep walking, past the entrance to a restaurant and a cafe or two. It will be facing you as you walk ahead. Each section of the staircase is slightly different. At the top of the staircase you would once have found the Navy Board Room, from where much of the administration of the Navy would have been managed, from the repair of ships to the needs of seamen. Nelson would have been a frequent visitor.

As an aid to reflection upon the ingenuity of this staircase, which twists and spirals up through all six floors, from the basement up, of this building, have a good look at something on the wall to the left of you just before you reach the foot of the staircase. It is a drawing of 1950 by F. S. Samuels, showing what the staircase looks like seen from above, as if you could magically peer right through the roof, and down into its spiralling movement. This drawing was made because the staircase was badly damaged during World War II, and it needed to be restored to its former glory. Its ingenious upward movement makes it look a bit like an artwork by M. C. Escher.

THE LADY FROM THE RUE DE CHAZELLES

We find ourselves in the Rue de Chazelles, the time in the early 1880s. Contrary to what one might think, the residents are not bothered by all the clanging, changing and hammering. Quite the opposite in fact, it fills them with pride. Within their quarter of Paris, La Plaine Mirocous, situated between Tenes and Batignolles, a reason is concerning skywards from Gagny, Gauthier & Cie, a workshop opposite the Parc Monceau.
