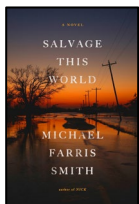

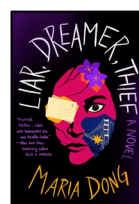
The Flames by Sophie Haydock- The Overlook Press- 9781419766312- HC- \$35.00- Historical Fiction- 464 pp.- March 2023

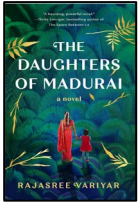
The Foxglove King by Hannah Whitten- Orbit- 9780316434997- HC- \$37.00- Fantasy- 480 pp.- March 2023

A propulsive debut that grapples with timely questions about what it means to be charitable, who deserves what, and who gets the power to decide.



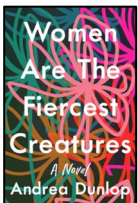

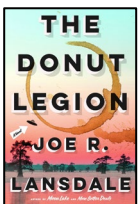
