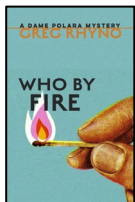

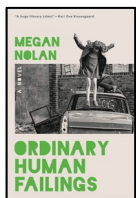
Who By Fire by Greg Rhyno - Cormorant Books- 9781770867420- TPB- \$24.95- Mystery- 280 pp.- April 2024

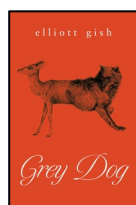
